ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (BLACKHEATH HILL/SHOOTERS HILL ROAD, THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH AND THE LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY BANNED LEFT TURN) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow Thames Water repair works to take place on Blackheath Hill/Shooters Hill Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left from Blackheath Hill into Hyde Vale.
The Order will be effective between 6th April 2020 and 8th April 2020 every night from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via **(for traffic travelling eastbound on Blackheath Hill wishing to turn left into Hyde Vale)** Shooters Hill Road, Shooters Hill Road Roundabout, Shooters Hill Road (westbound) to normal route of travel.
