ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 GLA ROAD (CHELSEA EMBANKMENT, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Tideway works to take place at A3212 Chelsea Embankment.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on A3212 Chelsea Embankment between its junctions with Chelsea Bridge Road and Embankment Gardens. The Order will be effective at certain times from 18th April 2020 until 20th April 2020 every night from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time
- to time be indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Beaufort Street, King's Road, Sloane Square, Lower Sloane Street, Chelsea Bridge Road to normal route of travel
