## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A3204 GLA SIDE ROAD (COURTENAY STREE

THE A3204 GLA SIDE ROAD (COURTENAY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow gas works to take place on Courtenay Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the loading bay on Courtenay Street side of No. 200 Kennington Lane. The Order will be effective from 07:00 AM 18th May 2020 until 11:59 PM 18th July 2020 or when the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
