ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 (NORWOOD ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, STOPPING AND 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow Utility works to take place on Norwood Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from
 - (I) entering Perran Road at its junction with Norwood Road;
 - (2) stopping in the loading and unloading bay outside Nos. 345-351
 - (3) exceeding a speed limit of 20 MPH on Norwood Road between its Junction with Thurlow Park Road and outside No.204 Norwood Road

The Order will allow all vehicles to use the northbound Bus lane on Norwood Road between its junction with Christchurch Road and Tulse Hill.

The Order will be effective from 05:00 AM 27th April 2020 until 10:00 PM 30th June 2020 or when the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Norwood Road, Christchurch Road and Perran Road to normal route of travel.
