ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (NEW KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1), (5), (7) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and is satisfied that these works will last in excess of 18 months for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable development and regeneration works on the A201 New Kent Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to:
 - (1) prohibit pedal cyclists from using the 130 metre length footway on New Kent Road, opposite its junctions with Falmouth Road and Meadow Row:
 - (2) allow pedal cyclists to use the 94 metre length footway on the northern side of New Kent Road, between its junctions with Falmouth Road and Meadow Row:
 - (3) allow pedal cyclists to use the 57 metre length footway on New Kent Road, between Rodney Place and Falmouth Road:
 - (4) allow pedal cyclists to use the 25 metre length footway on the south-western side of New Kent Road, (opposite Meadow Row).
 - The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on the 18th May 2020 until the works have been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. The Order will be revoked upon completion of these works.
