ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place at A23 Streatham High Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or exiting Leigham Avenue at its junction with Streatham High Road;
 - (2) stopping in the loading bay outside No.16 Leigham Avenue;
 - (3) stopping in the parking bay opposite No.16 Leigham Avenue.The Order will be effective at certain times from 08:00 AM 3rd June 2020 until 11:59 PM 6th June 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via **(for northbound traffic)** Streatham High Road, Leigham Court Road, Culverhouse Gardens, Gracefield Gardens and Woodleigh Gardens to normal route of travel **(for southbound traffic)** Streatham High Road, Gracefield Gardens and Woodleigh Gardens normal route of travel.
