ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (YORK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow resurfacing works to take place at A3200 York Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding on the northbound carriageway of the A3200 York Road between its junctions with Chicheley Street and Concert Hall Approach. This Order will allow all vehicles to use the bus lane on A3200 York Road between its junctions with Leake Street and Concert Hall Approach.

The Order will be effective between 3rd June 2020 and 7th June 2020 every night from 8:00 PM until 05:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via **(for northbound traffic)** York Road, Chicheley Street, Belvedere Road and Concert Hall Approach to normal route of travel **(traffic accessing York Road from Chicheley Street)** York Road, Addington Street, Westminster Bridge Road, Baylis Road, Waterloo Road and York Road to normal route of travel.
