Regulation Act 1984 as amended by The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 because of the likelihood of danger to the public on and adjacent to the highway. The order allows social distancing measures to be provided at various locations. The effects of the order are indicated below. (1) No access from:- (i) South Row to Montpelier Vale and Prince of Wales Road; (ii) Montpelier Vale and Prince of Wales Road to South Row;

(iii) Silverdale to Bishopsthorpe Road; and (iv) Bishopsthorpe Road to Silverdale: (2) Road closure in (i) George Lane between a point 2 metres east of the projected boundary of Nos. 173/175 George Lane and a point 5 metres west of the projected boundary of Nos. 175/177 George Lane; (ii) Glenbow Road between a point 5 metres south of the projected boundary of Nos. 50/52 Glenbow Road and the projected southern

- boundary of No. 52 Glenbow Road; (iii) Kitto Road at the width restricted exit to Pepys Road: (iv) Silverdale between a point 3 metres north of the projected northern kerbline of Grace Path and a point 5 metres north of the projected northern kerbline of Grace Path; and (v) Scawen Road between the projected southern boundary of No 63 Scawen Road and northern kerbline of Grinstead Road: (3) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the closures and banned movements in article 1(1) and 1(2) above are via local neighbouring roads. 2. Exemption is provided in the order for motorcycles, vehicles being engaged on highway maintenance works at those locations, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and
- anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform 3. The order comes into force on the 6th July 2020 to remain in force
- for up to 18 months. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
