Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Play Green Way, SE6)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Play Green Way between Randlesdown Road and Firhill Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition in article 2(1) are via (i) Randlesdown Road, Bellingham Green, Swallands Road and Firhill Road, and vice versa; or (ii) via Randlesdown Road and Firhill Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 1st September 2020 to remain in force for up to 3 months.
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.

(Note: Works are planned to take place between 14th and 18th September 2020)
