Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Queenswood Road and Berryman's Lane, SE26) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Queenswood Road, between Nos. 55/57 and 73/75, and (ii) Berryman's Lane. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition in article 2(1) shall be (i) for the Queenswood Road closure, via Queenswood Road, Mayow Road, De Frene Road, Perry Rise and Queenswood Road, and (ii) for the Berryman's Lane closure, via Sydenham Road and Mayow Road.
- 2.** The one way working in Berryman's Lane shall be suspended during the works.
- 3.** Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 4.** The order is intended to come into force on the 20th July 2020 to remain in force for up to 4 months.
- 5.** The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
