ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 GLA ROADS (GROSVENOR ROAD AND MILLBANK, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London having consulting the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to introduce social distancing measures on or near sections of the A3212 Grosvenor Road and Millbank because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic.
 The effect of the Order will be to:
 - (I) except pedal cycles to turn left into Bessborough Gardens from the A3212 Grosvenor Road:
 - (2) remove the loading and unloading bay outside No.60 Millbank;
 (3) change the operating hours of the south-westbound bus lane on the A3212 Millbank between its junctions with Ponsonby Terrace and Atterbury Street from Monday to Saturday 7am to 7pm to bus lane
 - at any time;
 (4) remove the solo motorcycle only bay outside Nos.2 I-24 Millbank
 - Tower, Millbank;
 (5) suspend the coach parking bay adjacent and opposite No.44a
 - (6) stop at any time on south-western kerbline of the A3212 Millbank opposite Nos.45 and 48-57 Millbank; Measures not imposed by the Order
 - (7) increase the width of the bus lane on the A3212 Millbank between its junctions with Ponsonby Terrace and Atterbury Street to 6.5 metres;
 (8) suspend the bus stops on Millbank outside and opposite Thames
 - House Millbank. The bus stop opposite Thames House, Millbank will be moved opposite the Millbank Tower;

 (0) the City of Westminster controlled coach parking pay opposite the
 - (9) the City of Westminster controlled coach parking pay opposite the Millbank Tower are suspended.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.01 AM on 11th July 2020 until 11:59 PM on 10th January 2022 or when the social distancing measures are not required, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
