

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – FAYGATE ROAD,
AMESBURY AVENUE AND BARCOMBE AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable the construction of road humps and other traffic calming measures to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Faygate Road which lies between Cricklade Avenue and Lydhurst Avenue and the road at the junctions of Amesbury Avenue and Barcombe Avenue with Faygate Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closures described above would be available via (a) Cricklade Avenue, Emsworth Street, Amesbury Avenue and Hailsham Avenue and vice versa; and (b) Amesbury Avenue, Hillside Road and Cricklade Avenue.

3. The road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 16th August 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 weeks (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner, although in practice it is anticipated that it will only have effect for about 1 or 2 days.
