

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – GREENHURST
ROAD AND LAMBERHURST ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable road junction improvement works (including footway and carriageway resurfacing) to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-

- (a) that length of Greenhurst Road which lies between Truslove Road and Lakeview Road; and
- (b) that length of Lamberhurst Road that lies between Greenhurst Road and the eastern boundary of No. 92 Lamberhurst Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the road closures described above would be available via (a) Greenhurst Road, Cheviot Road and Lamberhurst Road and vice versa; and (b) via Truslove Road, Greenhurst Road, Cheviot Road and Lamberhurst Road and vice versa.

3. The road closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs, and vehicles would be able to gain access to and egress from properties, as far as the extent of the works permits it.

4. The Order would come into force on 20th August 2020 it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 weeks (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner, although it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for about 1 or 2 days.
