'OUR STREETS' – KNIGHT'S HILL

AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND INTRODUCTION OF NEW 'AT ANY TIME' WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN BEWLYS ROAD, BROXHOLM ROAD, CANTERBURY GROVE, CHEVIOT ROAD, GLENNIE ROAD, IVYMONT ROAD, KNOLLYS ROAD, LAMBERHURST ROAD, LEAF GROVE, LEIGHAM COURT ROAD AND ROXBURGH ROAD

(NOTE: This Notice is about the introduction of new or extension of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) in various roads.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 26th August 2020 made the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 294) Order 2020 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 31st August 2020.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to ban waiting by vehicles at any time (to be indicated by double yellow lines) in the lengths of street specified in the Schedule to this Notice (waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading would be permitted, subject to certain time limits and conditions).

3. The ban on waiting by vehicles is necessary to improve sightlines and visibility for drivers and pedestrians, maintain clear access routes at road junctions and improve road safety.

However, owing to restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, this is not currently possible and documents are therefore available for inspection on line at: www.lambeth.gov.uk/traffic-management-orders. 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE

(i) Bewlys Road, both sides, between Roxburgh Road and a point 10 metres east of Roxburgh Road. **(ii) Broxholm Road**, (a) both sides, between a point 3 metres west of Royal Circus and a point 10 metres west of Royal Circus; (b) both sides, between a point 4 metres north-east of Leigham Court Road and a point 10 metres north-east of Leigham Court Road. **(iii) Canterbury Grove**, (a) the north-west side, (i) between a point 3 metres south-west of Ivymont Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Ivymont Road; (ii) between a point 3 metres north-east of Ivymont Road and a point 10 metres north-east of Ivymont Road; (b) the south-east side, (i) between a point 3 metres south-west of Uffington Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Uffington Road; and (ii) between a point 3 metres north-east of Uffington Road and a point 10 metres north-east of Uffington Road. **(iv) Cameron Place**, so much as is public highway. **(v) Cheviot Road**, (a) both sides, between a point 10 metres west of Greenhurst Road and a point 10 metres east of Greenhurst Road; (b) the south-east side, between a point 5.1 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 7 and 9 Cheviot Road and the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 54 Cheviot Road; **(vi) Glennie Road**, (a) both sides, between a point 5 metres north-east of Leigham Court Road and a point 10 metres north-east of Leigham Court Road; (b) the south-east side, (i) between a point 3 metres south-west of Ivymont Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Ivymont Road; and (ii) between a point 3 metres north-east of Ivymont Road and a point 11.5 metres north-east of Ivymont Road. **(vii) Greenhurst Road**, both sides, between a point 10 metres south of Cheviot Road and a point 10 metres north of Cheviot Road. **(viii) Ivymont Road**, (a) both sides, between a point 3 metres south-east of Glennie Road and a point 10 metres south-east of Glennie Road, measured on the south-west side; (b) both sides, between a point 3 metres north-west of Canterbury Grove and a point 10 metres north-west of Canterbury Grove. **(ix) Knollys Road**, the north side, between a point 5 metres west of Cameron Place and a point 5 metres east of Cameron Place. **(x) Lamberhurst Road**, the west side, (a) between a point 3 metres north of Leaf Grove and a point 10 metres north of Leaf Grove; and (b) between a point 3 metres south of Leaf Grove and a point 10 metres south of Leaf Grove. **(xi) Leaf Grove**, both sides, between Lamberhurst Road and a point 10 metres west of Lamberhurst Road. **(xii) Leigham Court Road** (a) the north-east side, (i) between a point 4 metres north-west Glennie Road and a point 10 metres north-west of Glennie Road; (ii) between a point 4 metres north-west of Broxholm Road and a point 10 metres north-west of Broxholm Road; and (iii) between a point 4 metres south-east of Broxholm Road and a point 8.6 metres south-east of Broxholm Road. **(xiii) Roxburgh Road**, (a) the south-east side, (i) between Cheviot Road and a point 8 metres south-west of the common boundary of No. 9 Cheviot Road and No. 1 Roxburgh Road; (ii) between a point 10 metres north-east of Bewlys Road and a point 10 metres south-west of Bewlys Road; (b) the north-west side, between Cheviot Road and a point 3.4 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 3 Roxburgh Road; **(xiv) Royal Circus**, the west side, between a point 10 metres north of Broxholm Road and a point 10 metres south of Broxholm Road. **(xv) Uffington Road**, both sides, between a point 3 metres south-east of Canterbury Grove and a point 10 metres south-east of Canterbury Grove.
