

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Rowland Hamilton has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the Grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises: Mingles Bar & Restaurant Limited, 260 Brixton Road Lambeth SW9 6AQ which would authorise the following licensable activities:

The proposed application is to allow for the supply of alcohol, live music and recorded music, Sundays to Thursdays from 11:00 hours to 00:30 hours and on Fridays and Saturdays from 11:00 hours to 01:30 hours, to allow late night refreshment Sundays to Thursdays from 23:00 hours to 00:30 hours and Fridays and Saturdays from 23:00 hours to 01:30 hours and to allow the premises to open from 11:00 hours to 01:00 hours Sundays to Thursdays and on Fridays and Saturdays from 11:00 hours to 02:00 hours, full details of which can be inspected on the application.

This must be received in writing by: **1st September 2020**, clearly stating the grounds upon which representation is made, relevant to the Licensing Act 2003.
