ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY REVERSAL OF THE ONE-WAY SYSTEM
PALFREY PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of a likelihood of danger to the public posed by vehicles to pedestrians in a relatively narrow road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to continue to temporarily suspend the existing one-way system in that length of Palfrey Place which lies between Fentiman Road and Richborne Terrace in a direction towards Richborne Terrace and impose a one-way system in that length of Palfrey Place in a direction towards Fentiman Road instead.

2. The Order continues the effect of a notice issued by the Council under section 14(2) of the Road traffic Regulation Act 1984, which has suspended the existing one-way system and imposed the one-way traffic system since 27th July 2020.

3. An alternative route is available for vehicles affected by the reversal of the one-way system via Fentiman Road, Carroun Road and Richborne Terrace.

4. The one-way system will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order will come into force on 17th August 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months.
