ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (NO THROUGH ROAD FOR MOTOR VEHICLES) IN PULROSS ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of a likelihood of danger to the public due to an increase in pedestrians and pedal cyclists using certain roads following restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily impose a ban on motor vehicles using Pulross Road as a through road. This will be achieved by banning:

- (a) eastbound motor vehicles in the part of Pulross Road that lies west of the eastern kerb-line of Dalyell Road (including vehicles exiting Dalyell Road) from proceeding further east than that kerb-line; and
- (b) westbound motor vehicles in the part of Pulross Road that lies east of the common boundary of Nos. 62 and 63 Pulross Road from proceeding further west than that common boundary.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above restrictions will be available via adjacent roads.

3. The temporary traffic restrictions described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 17th August 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months.
