 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of a likelihood. of danger to the public due to an increase in pedestrians and pedal cyclists using certain roads following restrictions

- relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily impose a ban on motor vehicles using Pulross Road as a through road. This would be achieved by banning: (a) eastbound motor vehicles in the part of Pulross Road
 - (including vehicles exiting Dalvell Road) from proceeding further east than that kerb-line; and (b) westbound motor vehicles in the part of Pulross Road that lies east of the common boundary of Nos.

that lies west of the eastern kerb-line of Dalvell Road

- 62 and 63 Pulross Road from proceeding further west than that common boundary.
- 2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above restrictions would be available via adjacent roads.
- 3. The temporary traffic restrictions described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 17th August 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months
