

## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

### **Application for Grant of Premises Licence**

Jimmy Garcia Catering Limited has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

Queens Walk, Southbank Centre, London, SE1 8XX which would authorise the following licensable activities:

from 1 September 2020 to 17 January 2021

Supply of Alcohol: Every Day 11am – 11pm and New Year's Eve - from the start of permitted hours until 3am New Year's Day.

Late Night Refreshment: New Year's Eve - from the start of permitted hours until 3am New Year's Day.

Recorded Music: Every Day 11am – 11pm and New Year's Eve - from the start of permitted hours until 3am New Year's Day.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
