BOAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE SALAMANCA STREET FOR BRIDGE MAINTENANCE WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge maintenance works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Salamanca Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of

which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Salamanca Street which lies between Salamanca Place and Randall Row. 2. Alternative routes for vehicles would be available via (i)

Albert Embankment, Black Prince Road and Vauxhall Walk: and (ii) Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street, Albert Embankment, Black Prince Boad and the Albert Embankment service road fronting Nos. 9 to 20 Albert Embankment.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order would come into force on 5th September 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 4 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect between 10 pm and 6 am on 5th and 6th

September 2020, 12th and 13th September 2020, 19th and 20th September 2020 and 26th and 27th September 2020, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
