1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable UK Power
Networks to carry out maintenance and repair works, the
Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make

an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban

vehicles from entering or exiting Theed Street at the southern kerb-line of Whittlesey Street (opposite the party wall of Nos. 5 and 6 Theed Street).

2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.

3. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be

available via Whittlesey Street and Cornwall Road and the one-way traffic system in Roupell Street, between Theed Street and Cornwall Road, would be suspended to facilitate access and egress to properties.

4. The Order would come into force on 9th September 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 9th September until 16th September 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up
