## The Lewisham (Coulgate Street, SE4) (Covid-19) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary

traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 because of the likelihood of danger to the public on and adjacent to the highway, and that it was necessary to make the order for purposes connected to coronavirus so as to maintain social distancing on and adjacent to the highway in Coulgate Street, SE4. The order allows social distancing measures to be provided. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

- 1. (1) Road closure for all vehicles in Coulgate Street between Brockley Cross and Foxberry Road. (2) The diversion route for traffic affected by the closure is via Brockley Road and Foxberry Road.
- 2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 31st August 2020 to remain in force for up to 18 months.
- **4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
