LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) Road and public footpath closure and no parking/waiting in Railway Children's Walk, SE12 & BR1 between Baring Road and Reigate Road. (2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the prohibition in article 2(1) are via Baring Road, Downham Way, Northover, Shroffold Road and Reigate Road, or Reigate Road, Downham Way and Baring Road. (3) The alternative route for pedestrian traffic affected by the prohibition in article 2(1) shall be via Baring Road, Downham Way, and Reigate Road, and vice versa.
- 2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 1st September 2020 to remain in
- force for up to 3 months.

(Note: It is intended that the works be completed within 3 weeks) 4. The restriction apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway. Dated 7th August 2020.
