

## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

### **Notice of application to Vary a Premises Licence**

Edoardo Archetta has applied to Wandsworth Council to vary the premises licence at: Bucci Restaurant, 195 Balham High Road, London, SW12 9BE.

As follows:

The application seeks to ADD the sale by retail of alcohol for consumption OFF the premises to the current license. Hours sought are from Monday to Saturday from 10:00am 'til 00:00 and Sunday from 12:00 'til 23:30; And to add Late Night Refreshment OFF the Premises Monday To Saturday from 23:00 until 00:30 and Sunday's From 23:00 until 00:00; Also to remove the following condition: 'Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal'.
