

# Transport for London Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A200 GLA ROAD (ST THOMAS STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane operation works to take place at A200 St Thomas Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (1) entering or proceeding on St Thomas Street between its junctions with Borough High Street and Bermondsey Street. Local access will be maintained;
  - (2) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay outside Keats House, Nos.26-28 St Thomas Street;
  - (3) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay outside St Thomas's Church, No.9A St Thomas Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 5th September 2020 and 14th September 2020, every Saturday at 12:01 AM until Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via: **(for traffic wishing to travel westerly on St Thomas Street)** St Thomas street, Bermondsey Street, Tooley Street and Borough High Street to normal route of travel; **(for traffic wishing to travel easterly on St Thomas Street)** Borough High Street, Tooley Street, Jamaica Road, Abbey Street and Bermondsey Street to normal route of travel.
