ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (SUDBOURNE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under sections 14(1), (5), (7) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and is satisfied that these works will last in excess of 18 months for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable construction works to take place on the A23 GLA Side Road, Sudbourne Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to suspend any vehicle from stopping at any time in the Parking Bay located on Sudbourne Road, near its junction with the A23 Brixton Hill.
 The Order will be effective from 00.01 AM on the 1st October 2020

until the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. The Order will be revoked upon completion of these works.
