of danger to the public due to an increase in pedestrians pedal cyclists using Larkhall Rise, following restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an

(a) ban motor vehicles proceeding in a north-easterly direction in the part of Larkhall Rise that lies southwest of the north-eastern side of Edgeley Road from proceeding past the north-eastern side of Edgelev Road and across the bridge over the railway; and (b) suspend the cycle lanes on both sides of the part of

Larkhall Rise that comprises the bridge over the

Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

railway and allow pedal cycles to use the middle of the carriageway of that part of Larkhall Rise (where motor vehicles will be banned) instead. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the restriction. described in paragraph 1(a) above will be available via adiacent routes.

3. The temporary restrictions will enable parts of the carriageway of Larkhall Rise, where it comprises the bridge over the railway, to be sectioned off and made available to

pedestrians. 4. The Order will come into force on 21st September 2020
