

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH  
CHANGES TO PARKING PLACES AND WAITING  
RESTRICTIONS IN WALCOT SQUARE**

*(NOTE: This Notice is about changes to the existing residents' parking places in the lengths of Walcot Square referred to below and the introduction of at any time waiting restrictions (indicated by double yellow lines) to enable the construction of a new dropped kerb to enable vehicular access to properties.)*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 23rd September 2020 made the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. 3) Order 2020 and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 295) Order 2020 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into force on 28th September 2020.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be in Walcot Square on the north side of the east to west arm to:-

- (a) reinstate a redundant vehicular crossover opposite No. 6 Walcot Square and extend the adjacent residents' parking place;
- (b) remove a length of residents' parking place at the side of No. 9 Walcot Square and ban waiting at any time (indicated by double yellow lines) in that length of road instead.

3. The Orders are required to (a) remove a length of parking space adjacent to a dropped kerb so as to allow vehicular access to properties; and (b) provide new parking space where a dropped kerb is being removed.

A copy of the Orders and other documents giving particulars about the Orders (including a map) would usually be made available for inspection the offices of Lambeth Council's Highways Team (Resident Services), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG. However, owing to restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, this is not currently possible and documents are therefore available for inspection on line at: [www.lambeth.gov.uk/traffic-management-orders](http://www.lambeth.gov.uk/traffic-management-orders). 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
