ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA ROAD (BALHAM HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN AND TEMPORARY PROHIBITON OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable social distancing and improved cycling facilities to be introduced on or near the A24 Balham High Road because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- 3. The effects of the Order will be to:
 - (I) prohibit any vehicle except buses to turn right into Bedford Hill from Balham High Road;
 - (2) remove the disabled persons vehicle bay on Ravenswood Road side of No.17 Balham High Road replacing it with single double red line (no stopping between Monday-Saturday 7am-7pm);
 - (3) introduce a raised table Zebra Crossing opposite No. 29 Balham High Road serving the bus stop at that location. The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on the 28th

September 2020 until 11:59 PM on the 25th March 2022 or when social distancing is not required whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of for the purposes of those restrictions or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
