## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (BROWNHILL ROAD/ ST MILDREDS ROAD/ WESTHORNE AVENUE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow bridge inspection works to take place on St Mildreds Road.

(I) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on St Mildreds Road

- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - between its junctions with Hither Green Lane and Milborough Crescent;
    (2) entering or proceeding on Brownhill Road/ St Mildreds Road
    - (2) entering or proceeding on Brownhill Road/ St Mildreds Road between their junctions with Rushey Green and Hither Green Lane, residential access will be maintained;
    - (3) entering or proceeding on Westhorne Avenue/ St Mildreds Road between their junctions with Burnt Ash Hill and Milborough Crescent, residential access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective between on 10:00 PM on 29th September 2020 and 5:00 AM on 2nd October 2020 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Burnt Ash Hill, Burnt Ash Road, Lee High Road, Lee Bridge, Lewisham High Street, Molesworth Street, Lewisham High Street and Rushey Green or reverse to normal route of travel.
