ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow a crane operation to take place on Streatham High Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning left from Voss Court into Streatham High Road southbound; (2) stopping on Streatham High Road between Kempshott Road and Streatham Common South.

The Order will also permit all vehicles to us the northbound bus lane on Streatham High Road between its junction with Kempshott Road and No.496 Streatham High Road.

The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 28th September 2020 and 5:00 AM on 29th September 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Streatham High Road northbound, Gleneagle Road, Ambleside Avenue, Tooting Bec Gardens The Pavement - south-eastern arm, Clapham Common South Side and Streatham High Road southbound to normal route of travel.
