

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – KNIGHT’S HILL
AND BLOOM GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out works to repair a water main, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-

- (a) entering that length of Knight’s Hill which lies on the west side of the triangular island situated opposite West Norwood Library and West Norwood Cemetery and Crematorium, between the northern kerb-line of Bloom Grove and the party wall of Nos. 4 and 6 Knight’s Hill; and
- (b) entering or leaving Bloom Grove at its junction with Knight’s Hill, except for access to or egress from properties in Bloom Grove as directed by traffic marshals.

2. Alternative routes are available for vehicles affected by the road closure described in paragraph 1(a) above via Norwood High Street (southbound), Elder Road, Crown Dale, Crown Lane, Streatham Common North, Streatham High Road, Streatham Hill, Christchurch Road, Hardel Rise, Tulse Hill and Norwood Road. An alternative route does not apply in relation to the closure described in paragraph 1(b) above as Bloom Grove is a cul-de-sac.

3. The road closures described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 6th November 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 10 pm on 6th November 2020 until 6 am on 7th November 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 6 months.
