

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
PROPOSED CHANGES TO PARKING PLACES AND
WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN MONTFORD PLACE

(NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to extend the length of an existing shared use residents' and pay by phone parking space adjacent to a dropped kerb that is being removed and the reduction of a length of shared use residents' and pay by phone parking space further along this stretch of road and replacing it with at any time waiting restrictions (indicated by double yellow lines) to enable the construction of a two new dropped kerbs to enable vehicular access to a new development – see paragraph 6.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. **) Order 202* and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. ***) Order 202* under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be in Montford Place on the west side to:-

- (a) reinstate a redundant vehicular crossover and extend the adjacent shared use residents' and pay by phone parking places;
- (b) reduce the length of an existing shared use residents' and pay by phone parking place opposite No. 20 Montford Place and ban waiting at any time (indicated by double yellow lines) in those lengths of road instead.

3. The proposed Orders are required to (a) remove a length of parking space adjacent to two dropped kerbs in Montford Place so as to allow vehicular access and egress to properties; and (b) provide new parking space where a dropped kerb is being removed.
