LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham

(Various Roads) (Resurfacing) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary

traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of resurfacing works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1. Road closure and no parking/waiting in:- (i) Achilles Street, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via local neighbouring roads and the A2; (ii) Alan Pegg Place, there is no alternative route for vehicular traffic; (iii) Eliot Hill, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via Wat Tyler Road, Hare and Billel Road and Mounts Pond Road; (iv) Hilther Green Lane, between Ardgowan Road and Thornford Road, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via Theodore Road and Radford Road; (v) Montacute Road, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via Bankhurst Road and Ravensbourne Park; (vi) Mounts Pond Road, between Eliot Hill Aberdeen Terrace, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via Wat Tyler Road, Hare and Biller Road and Mounts Pond Road; (vii) Nash Road, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via St. Norbert Road and Turnham Road; and (viii) Ravensbourne Crescent, the alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected are via Ravensbourne Park, Bankhurst Road and Casslee Road.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 9th November 2020 to remain in force for up to 5 months.
- (Note: The majority of roads in article 1 above will be closed for two or three days, or in the case of Hither Green Lane and Alan Pegg Place, nights. The duration of the closure generally being relative to its length. Residents and businesses in all roads will receive prior written notification with an indication of the extent, dates and duration of any works)
- ${\bf 4.} \;\;$ The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
