1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water to carry out repairs to a collapsed sewer, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles:-

(i) proceeding in Brixton Road from entering St John's Crescent (an alternative route will be available for vehicles affected by the "No Entry" via Brixton Road, Villa Road, Wiltshire Road and St John's Crescent): (ii) from entering that length of Gresham Road which lies between A23 Brixton Boad and the western kerb-line

of Wiltshire Road (alternative routes are available for affected vehicles via (a) Brixton Road, Effra Road, Morval Road, Dalberg Road, Dulwich Road, Norwood Road, Half Moon Lane, Herne Hill, Denmark Hill and Coldharbour Lane; and (b) Wiltshire Road and St John's Crescent).

The restrictions will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the

appropriate traffic signs. The Order will come into force on 8th December 2020. and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner
