ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London having consulted with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable sewer repair works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Brixton Road, between the extended southern building line of Nos. 336/338 Brixton Road and its junction with Wynne Road. All northbound vehicles will be permitted to use the bus lane located between the extended southern building line of Nos. 336/338 Brixton
 - The Order will be effective from 08.00 AM on 9 December 2020 until 07:00 PM on 18 December 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

Road and its junction with Wynne Road.

- (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
