## **Transport for London Notice**

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2020

- I. Transport for London having consulted with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable utility works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicles on Brixton Road to turn left into Stockwell Road.
  The Order will be effective from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM each night from 14 December 2020 until 16 December 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a polic constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs: via Ferndale Road, Bellefields Road, Stockwell Road and then to normal route of travel.
