ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A3203 GLA ROAD (LAMBETH BRIDGE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecommunications works to take place on Lambeth Bridge.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on Lambeth Bridge eastbound between its junctions with Millbank and Albert Embankment/ Lambeth Palace Road. The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 19th December 2020 and 5:00 AM on 27th December 2020 every Saturday night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Millbank northbound, Abingdon Street, St Margaret Street, Parliament Square, Bridge Street, Westminster Bridge, Westminster Bridge Road, and Lambeth Palace Road to normal route of travel.
