ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A201 GLA SIDE ROAD (THE CUT, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London in agreement with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow footway improvement works to take place on The Cut.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - entering or proceeding on The Cut eastbound between its junctions with Hatfields and Blackfriars Road, access will be maintained between Hatfields and Joad Street;
 - (2) stopping in the Permit Holders only bay outside No.I Joan Street. The Order will be effective between 7:00 PM on 30th November 2020 and 5:00 AM on 24th January 2021 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;(2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Hatfields and Stamford Street to normal route of travel.
