 2. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the

The order will come into force on 18th January 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in 4 phases so that it will not apply to the lengths of Broxholm Road specified in paragraph 1(a) above at any one time and that
