ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A217 GLA ROAD (ARMOURY WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane operation works to take place on Armoury Way.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right into A217 Fairfield Street from Armoury Way: (2) entering or exiting Old York Road at its junction with Armoury Way; The Order will be effective between 4:00 AM on 23rd January 2021
 - until 7:00 PM on 24th January 2021 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Swandon Way to normal route of travel.
