## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A3036 GLA ROAD (SOUTH LAMBETH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow rail construction works to take place on South Lambeth Road.
   The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in

the Parking bay on South Lambeth Road outside Vauxhall Station

- entrance (western side, 40 metres south of the junction of Kennington Lane), except vehicle used in the connection of Vauxhall Station platform works.

  The Order will be effective between 12:01 AM on 1st January 2021 and 11:59 PM on 2nd January 2021 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as
- shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

  4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
    - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
