1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out safely, the Council of the

London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from

entering that length of Valleyfield Road which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 34 and 36 Valleyfield Road and the common boundary of Nos. 42 and 44 Valley Road inclusive.

 The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

available via Valley Road, Streatham Common North and Leigham Court Road and vice versa.

4. The Order would come into force on 1st March 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the

until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 1st and 5th March 2021 inclusive, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2
