LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PART OF A CYCLE LANE ON WANDSWORTH ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable railway bridge refurbishment works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend the part of

the southbound cycle lane on the east side of Wandsworth Road which lies between Wyvil Road and a point 180 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Wyvil Road.

Alternative routes are not applicable. The suspension of the cycle lane will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the

placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 8th February 2021 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner, although in practice it
