LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Brockley Cross, SE4 between Endwell Road and the northern arm of Coulgate Street. (2) The alternative route for vehicles affected by the prohibition is via Brockley Road, Adelaide Avenue, Ladywell Road, the A21, the A20, and Malpas Road, and vice versa.
 Exceptions are provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes, anything
- done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer, and vehicles engaged in highway operational and management duties.

 3. The order comes into force on the 25th February 2021 to remain in force for 2 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner. (Note:
