ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
 The purpose of the Order is to enable trunk sewer works to take place
- on Bermondsey Street.

 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except pedal cyles from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on A200 Bermondsey Street between its junctions with Crucifix Lane and Tooley Street;
 - The Order will also permit all vehicles to:
 - (2) turn left into Tooley Street from Tower Bridge Road;
 - (3) use the westbound bus lane on Tooley Street between its junction with Tower Bridge Road and Fair Street.

The Order will be effective between 1st March 2021 and 8th March 2021 every night 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via St Thomas Street, Borough High Street, Great Dover Street, Long Lane and Tower Bridge Road back to normal route of travel.
