INTRODUCTION OF "AT ANY TIME" WAITING RESTRICTIONS

(DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) IN GREENHURST ROAD AND LAMBERHURST ROAD

(NOTE: This Notice is about introducing a ban on waiting by vehicles at any time in parts of Greenhurst Road and Lamberhurst Road, at and near the junction of those two roads, to discourage parking near to that road junction.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 24th March 2021 made the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 304) Order 2021, under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Order, which will come into force on 27th March 2021, will be to ban waiting by vehicles at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice (this will be indicated on the road by double yellow lines).
3. The Order is necessary because the junction of Greenhurst Road and Lamberhurst Road was recently tightened to encourage lower vehicle speeds through the junction and improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians by improving sight lines and the informal pedestrian crossing facility. Reducing the carriageway has meant that waiting restrictions need to be implemented at the junction to protect pedestrian - driver sight lines by eliminating the ability for drivers of vehicles to park on the junction.

A copy of the Order and other documents giving detailed particulars about it (including maps) would usually be made available for inspection at the offices of Lambeth Council's Highways Team (Resident Services), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made. However, owing to restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, this is not currently possible and so the Order and other documents are available for inspection online at: www.lambeth.gov.uk/traffic-management-orders, during that six week period. 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE

Lamberhurst Road

the south side (adjacent to the side of No. 34 Greenhurst Road), between the western kerb-line of the southernmost arm of Greenhurst Road and a point 15 metres west of that kerb-line.

Greenhurst Road

- (a) the east side of the southernmost arm (outside Nos. 31 and 33 Greenhurst Road), between the south-eastern kerb-line of Greenhurst Road and a point 9.5 metres south of that kerb-line;
- (b) the west side of the southernmost arm (outside No. 34 Greenhurst Road), between the southern kerb-line of Lamberhurst Road and a point 9.5 metres south of that kerb-line;
- (c) the south-east side (outside No. 31 Greenhurst Road), between the eastern kerb-line of the southernmost arm of Greenhurst Road and a point 14.3 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

(Note: The southernmost arm of Greenhurst Road means the length of that road which lies south of the southern kerb-line of Lamberhurst Road.)
