via (i) Ferndale Hoad, Pulross Hoad, Bellefields Hoad, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthews Road, Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Brighton Terrace, Bernay's Grove, Tunstall Road and Shannon Grove; and (ii) Shannon Grove, Tunstall Road, Bernay's Grove, Brighton Terrace, Brixton Road and

Brighton Terrace, bernay's Grove, fundial Hoad and Shannon Grove; and (ii) Shannon Grove, Tunstall Road Bernay's Grove, Brighton Terrace, Brixton Road and Ferndale Road. 4. The Order will come into force on 21st March 2021 and

Ferndale Road.

4. The Order will come into force on 21st March 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect on 21st March 2021 for one day, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on that day the Order

may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 1 month.
