NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Reigate Road, BR1 between Ballamore Road and Downham Way. (2) The alternative routes for vehicles affected by the prohibition is via Ballamore Road, Shroffold Road,
- Northover and Downham Way. 2. The one way working in Reigate Road is suspended during the closure
- of Reigate Road. 3. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
- The order comes into force on the 17th May 2021 to remain in force for 3 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner. (Note: Duration of the works is expected to be 10 days.)
- 5. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
