ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (LAMBETH) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A3036 GLA ROAD (ALBERT EMBANKMENT) VARIATION ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that on 24 March 2021 it made the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 5th April 2021.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to install a new 11.5 metre long taxi rank bay on Albert Embankment, between its junctions with New Spring Gardens Walk and Glashouse Walk. (From a point 19 metres north of a point opposite the extended southern building line of No. 92 Tintagel House, Albert Embankment to a point 11.5 metres south).

The bay will operate every day from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

3. The road which would be affected by the Order is the A3036 GLA Road Albert Embankment in the London Borough of Lambeth.
4. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, to make the application for the purpose for the challenge to the High Court.
